



CUBA ITINERARY

This itinerary only covers Havana because areas/towns/cities outside of the capitol are not "food safe". Much of Cuba is still living in the past, and while this is utterly charming for the usual traveler, it does not accommodate those with special requirements. When we feel confident about the situation, we will be happy to include the beach, as well as other areas.



PLEASE NOTE: In the foreseeable future there will be regularly scheduled, commercial flights. We will then be able to adjust our arrivals/departures to meet the preferences of our individual travelers. Approval has been granted but nothing is yet in place. Until that time, charters are still the only option

SAMPLE 5 DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 - D (*Legend Meals indicated: B = breakfast, L = lunch, D = dinner*)

- Depart on charter flight from Miami, Orlando or JFK to [Havana Cuba](#). Please arrive 4 hours prior to flight time per CUBA charter requirement. \$28 per person Cuban tax due at check in.
- Upon arrival in Cuba, clear customs and immigration and locate your CTS representative for transfer to your hotel and check in. Your Cuban Tour Guide will accompany you throughout your 4-night journey. Unless noted otherwise all pick up/transfer/tours times will be determined on site with your guide.
- After collecting your bags and exiting customs, you will enjoy a Panoramic Havana City Tour. You will also learn about the different neighborhoods in Havana. Following the tour, check in at the Hotel
- Later that evening, you will experience Havana's famous traditional Cannon Firing Ceremony with dinner.
- Accommodations in Havana.

Day 2 - B, L, D

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- You will depart for a walk through [Old Havana](#) to learn firsthand about the recent restorations and the historical importance of many of its glorious buildings, many dating back to Colonial times. There are four major squares in Havana, which you will visit: [Plaza Vieja](#), [Plaza de la Catedral](#), Plaza de Armas and Plaza San Francisco. Visit to a local school.
- Visit the project [Jose Fuster](#). Lunch included. After lunch visit the Callejon de Hammel and then the [Bellas Artes Museum](#).
- Dinner at a local [Paladar](#)

Day 3 - B, L

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- Depart your hotel at 9:00 a.m. for a day of touring beautiful Havana. We will begin with a panoramic tour of modern Havana in antique cars and its amazing waterfront walkway, [El Malecon](#). We will visit the historical [Revolution Square](#), [Colon Cemetery](#) and the Avenue of the Presidents, one of the most beautiful avenues in Havana. We will also make a visit to Fifth Avenue, where many foreign embassies are located. After lunch at a Paladar, we will continue on to Las Terrazas de Cojimar, the fisherman's bar that Ernest Hemingway wrote about in The Old Man and the Sea, to enjoy a "Don Gregorio" cocktail. We will see [Finca Vigia](#), [Hemingways](#) Cuba house.
- In the evening, we will visit the world famous nightclub, the [Tropicana Cabaret](#). You will enjoy watching the glittering spectacle at this beautiful outdoor theater known as "Paradise under the Stars" with premium seating.

Day 4 - B, L

- Breakfast included at the hotel.
- Today we will visit Havana to learn more about tobacco and rum. We will start with a visit to a tobacco factory and then visit La Casa del Habano in [Miramar](#), a wonderful cigar shop and must-see for any cigar aficionado. Next, we will tour the [Havana Club Museum of Rum](#), located in the historic district of Old Havana. This museum offers an up-close look into the rum-making process and a taste of Cuban culture. CHARTER LUGGAGE PERMITTED

- Carry on luggage no more than 20lbs, plus 1 personal item (nothing over 20lbs. can go in the overhead)
- Checked luggage no more than 44lbs (\$3 per pound over) \$15 for each checked bag
- \$28 cash departure tax due at US departing airport when checking in
